Best Takeaway

- Must be based in Bradford District
- Must be trading for more than six months

- Must have South Asian curry on offer on their menu
- Offer takeaway service, for collection and delivery.
- Show consistent high quality and selection of dishes

Best Customer Service

- Ratings on Trip advisor and other online websites
- Décor/ambience
- Service standards by front of staff
- Cleanliness and display of cutlery crockery to a reasonable standard.

Best Outdoor Caterer

- Providing a delicious and creative range of catering for outdoor events
- Creativity in presentation of food
- Service standards for delivery and event management team

Best Chef

RULES & TERMS OF AWARDS

The nomination eligibility criteria period is: 1st February to – 18th March 2018 midnight. All nominees should be based in Bradford and District (see map of Bradford District or email nominate@bradfordcurryawards.co.uk for clarification)

When making nominations, please complete all contact details, for verification purposes, so we can validate nomination. Failure to do so may make the nomination void.

All nominations will be assessed by the Awards Panel* and a shortlist of five candidates for each award category will be selected.

Self-nominations are accepted.

The panel can only base their decision on the information in the nomination form, so please complete this to the best of your ability.

The deadline for making nominations is midnight on Sunday 18th March 2018 midnight

If a nomination is successful, the nominee will be contacted by the organisers of Bradford Curry Awards to invite them to attend Bradford Curry Awards ceremony on Tuesday 18th April 2018.

The entrant and the Nominee must be available for filming purposes or otherwise on two specified dates (as decided at the organisers sole discretion), between 19th March and 10th April 2018 (inclusive). If selected as a finalist, the entrant must be available to appear for press interviews and other ongoing publicity.

Proof of eligibility may be required. Failure to comply with the eligibility criteria as set out in these terms and conditions, and elsewhere as applicable or failure to comply with instructions and/or directions given or with these terms and conditions in any way may result in disqualification of the entrant and their nominee from the competition.
